Hiring Requirements:

Must possess a valid California driver's license/minimum vehicle insurance required by law and maintained throughout the duration of employment. Please note: Upon job offering a current California driver's license and a driving record acceptable to the Agency's insurance carrier is required.

No Driver can have any of the following in the last three years:

- i. More than 3 moving violations or 2 accidents.
- ii. No suspension or revocation of license
- iii. No single violation involving reckless driving, driving under the influence, racing or fleeing an officer or accident.

Pre-employment drug testing, FBI criminal background check and education/degree verification required. Reliable transportation while on duty is required.

Summary:

The Shelter Advocate will provide intervention and supportive services to individuals in crisis; victims and survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and other violent crimes.

Duties:

The Advocate provides case management to former survivors of domestic violence and homeless individuals and families, providing assistance and connection with services and supports to help clients remain stably housed. Using Motivational Interviewing and a collaborative approach, works with clients to develop and monitor individual service plans (ISP) which include educational, vocational, medical, life skills and housing goals.

Shift:

Shift work, some holidays, and weekends required.

Education & Experience:

Associates Degree and four years related work experience or Bachelors in Social Work and 2 years' experience working with victims and relevant training on working with the identified victim population.
